Thank you for your interest in providing a unique learning experience for your child. Our goal at Tate's is to challenge your child intellectually, inspire your child creatively, educate your child culturally, and enrich your child emotionally.

You recently contacted our office concerning the First Responder Scholarship. Tate's School does provide a limited number of scholarships each year. The requirements for eligibility are as follows:

- 1) One parent must serve as a first responder (defined as Fire-Rescue, Law Enforcement, EMT, or Military Personnel) and present documented proof.
- 2) The child must be between the ages of 3 -13 and a good student (i.e. hard working, well behaved, positive).
- 3) The family's yearly income must be modest.
- 4) Applications and all necessary information must be received by the **DEADLINE on MAY 28, 2019.**

Procedure for applying for the First Responder Scholarship

*(We must receive all the following items before we can begin to review;
Therefore, please submit all materials at one time.
You may return items by mail or bring by the administrative office.)*

- 1) Submit the student application for your child.
- 2) Send a letter telling us why you'd like your child to attend Tate's School and explain circumstances as to why you are requesting a scholarship.
- 3) Submit most recent income tax information (all personal financial information will be held with the utmost confidentiality).
- 4) Please enclose school records/report cards (for those enrolling in Kindergarten through 8th grade).
- 5) Please enclose other related records per the Student Records Checklist.

Your request will be reviewed by our Administrative Board. Due to increased requests and limited availability, it is recommended that people apply early for financial assistance.
